PIONEER SALOON AND/OR DEATH VALLEY - SATURDAY APRIL 27, 2024

The Pioneer Saloon is located in Good Springs, NV. We will leave from the Mall of America on Las Vegas Boulevard South, traveling on the old L. A. Highway to Good Springs for a brunch. Further details of this activity will be provided, once a decision is made to either go to the Pioneer Saloon on April 27, 2024, and/or Death Valley.

Bad Water Basin, Death Valley, is a salt flat, about an hour and a half drive from Pahrump, NV, and/or about two and a half hours from Las Vegas. A temporary lake, Lake Manly, has formed in Bad Water Basin this Spring due to the amount of rain received in that area from Hurricane Hilary and all of the rain over the past six months, amounting to a recorded 4.9 inches of rain. Park Rangers have been kayaking across the lake, Lake Manly, which is predicted to dry up by the end of April 2024. Lake Manly is named for pioneer William L. Manly. The lake span is six miles. The lake hasn't filled up since 2005, lasting for about a week at that time. Bad Water Basin is 282 feet below sea level and is the final destination for water from the Amargosa River, which begins in Beatty.

PICNIC AT THE ORCHARD - SATURDAY MAY 18, 2024

The annual club picnic will be at the Ahern Orchard. Please note a change to the picnic for this year--there will be no one barbecuing at the picnic. Each one will bring their own food and drinks; and, if you wish, you can bring a potluck item(s). A sign-up sheet will be passed around at the March, April, and May 2024, club meetings about the picnic, providing further details. FYI: It has been difficult, in the past, to come close to purchasing food for the picnic, without running short or having a lot of leftovers.
