#### April 20, 2024, Saturday, Las Ventanas:

Our annual Las Ventanas event is on 04/20/24. We should start showing up by about 8:00 A.M. The car show begins at 9:00 A.M. until 1:00 P.M. Las Ventanas serves breakfast and lunch items plus coffee and water. Las Ventanas is located at 10401 West Charleston Boulevard, south of Charleston. Enter from Charleston on Indigo Drive.

## April 27, 2024, Saturday, Death Valley National Park:

Tour to Bad Water Basin, Death Valley. We will meet at the Chevron Gas Station at Highways 159/160 (also known as West Charleston/The Blue Diamond Road.) We will leave the gas station at 8:00 A.M., bound for Pahrump, NV. I, Jeanie Prouty, will wait for you at the Pahrump Nugget which is located at the intersection of Highway 160 and Highway 372. The Pahrump Nugget is on the northwest corner of this intersection with plenty of parking. I will wait right next to the intersection, in the parking lot. As you arrive in this area, if you need to make a rest, food, and/or gas stop, there are gas stations right in this vicinity, as well as eating places, such as Mac Donald's and Arby's. After returning from Death Valley, we plan to eat at Denney's in Pahrump. If anyone would choose to eat elsewhere, that is certainly acceptable.

#### May 18, 2024, Saturday, Picnic at The Orchard:

Our annual picnic at The Orchard will begin at 10:00 A.M. The Orchard is off West Bonanza just west of MLK Boulevard. Enter the Orchard on Clarkway Drive from Bonanza. THIS IS A BRING YOUR OWN FOOD AND DRINK EVENT--THERE WILL BE NO BARBECUING OR COOKING. You can bring a pot luck item, if you wish. Electricity is available, if needed.

#### June 22, 2024, Mc Cormack Arcade:

This event will begin at 10:00 A.M. The arcade collection is located at 4625 Wynn Road. You enter the parking lot to the front of this building. The arcade is around, to the back, of the building. Suggestions have been made about where to eat after the event. We will decide on one at the May 2024 meeting.

FYI: (1): Both The Pioneer Saloon, Goodsprings, NV, and the Death Valley tour were tentatively scheduled for 04/27/24. The decision was made to go to Death Valley on the 27th and reschedule The Pioneer Saloon, which will be done. (2): Betty and Tom Rowlett are hosting the July Jamboree in Utah.
